Thursday Oct 17th 1850

Commenced with Light Breezes
and Cloudy Weather in co with
Ship Sylph at 12 noon saw sp.
Whale and lowered the boats
and at 2 Sylph Boat struck
and we chased the whale
and at

4 came on
Board 2 boats
the other still



in chase at 4 past 4 a large
Whale came up close to the
Ship and lowered the West Boat
and they at 8 got him to the
Ship Lat 38 20 Long 30 00
Bale in sight

Saturday Oct 31st 1850

Commenced with strong breezes and squally
Middle part the same

Latter strong breezes and squally
at 1 PM saw Mr. Whaley lowered

2 Boats and at 4 PM turned come
on Board without success they say

Lat 33 20 Long 23 10

Friday Nov 21st 1850

Saw 2 Whales going quick
to the wind did not lower

Lat 23 00 Long 19 28 West
