

From Barn. running at sea Lat 19 00 S Long 187 58
297th morning of the 14th to the 15th April
Was overtaken by the awful visitation of
gale at 5 o'clock in the morning of the 14th
it commenced blowing an awful Hurricane
28 at 10 the gale still increasing and the wind
7 blowing to the Northward and 12 it blowed awful
and at 5 the fore Topmast stay sail blowed
to pieces and it is impossible for canvas
to stand at this time at 7 cut away the
Fore and main Top Gallant Mast & yard to the
Ship and at 10 cut away Fore Main & Mizzen
29 Top Mast, the Wind blowing awful at this time
7 but our little Bark kept it like a
warrior at 12 past 10 the Larboard boat went
in pieces still hanging to the cranes & Davit
the main Top Mast took the head of the main
Mast at 12 the morning of 15th the 2nd Boat
kept clear of the wreck at 1 past 12 the wreck
28 is unmanageable at 1 got clear of all the broken
7 spars at 5 the gale at its height at 12
it abated a little and nothing but the
strongest ship and the best sea Boat
and gods protecting power can save us
28 at 12 the wind moderating a little
100 at 4 got some sail on her
