at 1 P. M. Saw Blackfish lowered but could
not strike Middle and latter parts fresh
winds from S. E. to S. S. E. heading S. S. W.
to S. W. under all sail Lat. by Obs. $2^{\circ} 16' 11''$ S
Long by Obs. $11^{\circ} 48' 11''$ W

Wednesday November the 11th
Commences fresh winds from S. W. heading
S. S. W. under all sail, employed in various
jobs about the ship a head wind and know-
sings of a fair one, as I can see Middle
and latter parts fresh winds from S. S. E.
heading S. W. Lat. by Obs. $10^{\circ} 11' 11''$ S
Long by Obs. $13^{\circ} 15' 11''$ W

Thursday November the 12th
Commences fresh winds from S. S. E. heading
S. W. under all sail Middle and latter
part fresh winds from S. E. steering S. S. W.
fore and main Topgallant sails in
Lat. by Obs. $00^{\circ} 33' 11''$ S
Long by Obs. $14^{\circ} 49' 11''$ W
