Commences thick overcast weather from N.E.W. heading South under double reefs, Middle part calms and rain, at daylight made all sail, and tack'd to W. by Wind S.W. by S. Lat. by Obs. 41. 29. S. Long. by Chron. 163. 06. W.

Wednesday January the 4<sup>th</sup>  
Commences fresh winds from S.W. heading N. by S. under double reefs, Middle part light winds, latter fresh winds and squally from the Westward heading South and S.W. under double reefs. Lat. by Obs. 41. 05. S. Long. by Chron. 163. 29. W.

Thursday January the 5<sup>th</sup>  
Commences fresh winds and squally weather from West, at sunset tack in sail heading S.W. caught a Porpoise, Middle part light winds and calms at daylight made all sail heading S.W. at 11 A.M. tack'd to the S.W. wind from N.E.W. Lat. by Obs. 41. 58. S. Long. by Chron. 163. 49. W.

Friday January the 6<sup>th</sup>  
Commences fine breezes from N.E.W. heading S.W. under all sail, at 4 P.M. tack to N.E.W. wind from S.W. Middle and latter parts light winds from W. to N.E.W. working to the Westward. Lat. by Obs. 41. 14. S. Long. by Chron. 164. 10. W.

Saturday January the 7<sup>th</sup>  
Commences fine weather from the Westward heading N.W. by S. at 3 P.M. tack'd to the Southward, Middle part fine weather from N.E.W. heading South, at 11 P.M. tack'd to S.W. latter the same. Lat. by Obs. 41. 16. S. Long. by Chron. 164. 40. W.

Sunday January the 8<sup>th</sup>  
Commences fine breezes from S.W. heading N.E.W. under all sail, Middle and latter parts light breezes, and calms from S.E.W. heading West, under all sail. Lat. by Obs. 40. 57. S. Long. by Chron. 165. 04. W.

Monday January the 9<sup>th</sup>  
Commences light breezes and calms from S.E.W. heading West, at 4 P.M. the wind haul'd to S.E. steering S.E.W. under all sail, Middle and latter parts light winds and calms from every point in the compass. Lat. by Obs. 40. 54. S. Long. by Chron. 165. 29. W.

Tuesday Jan, the 10<sup>th</sup>  
Commences light winds and calms from West, at 4 shifted to S.E.W. tack'd to West Middle and latter parts light breezes from S.E.W. to South heading from West. to N.E.W. Lat. by Obs. 40. 41. S. Long. by Chron. 166. 25. W.

Wednesday Jan, the 11<sup>th</sup>  
Commences light breezes and clear weather from S.W. heading on the wind, Middle and latter parts fine from the South and West, steering S.E.W. Lat. by Obs. 41. 24. S. Long. by Chron. 166.

Thursday January the 12<sup>th</sup>  
Commences fine breezes from the South and West steering S.W. by S. under all sail, at 4 P.M. tack in main Tappallant sail Middle and latter parts the same. Lat. by Obs. 41. 56. S. Long. by Chron. 169. 16. W.
