Tuesday January the 31st
Commences fine weather from S.E. by E. at
4 P.M. lowered for struck and kil'd two
and at 6 P.M. took
them along side, and
took in sail, Middle
and Latter parts fine weather
at 5 P.M. commenced
cutting at 10 P.M.
finish'd and began to hail, Land
20 miles distant, Lat 44 11

Wednesday February the 1st
Commences fine weather from N.E. employed
hailing heading E.S.E. under easy sail.
Middle part the same at 5 P.M. lowered
for Wright Whales struck and kil'd one and at
six took him along
side, at 10 P.M. commenced
cutting at 10 P.M. finish'd fine
weather from N.W. employed
hailing, Land
18 miles distant, heading N.W. Lat 44 15

Thursday February the 2^d Long 194. 12 E.
Commences fine weather from N.W. heading
N.E. at 10 P.M. wore to the Westward
employed hailing Middle part fine Latter
the same at 6 P.M. lowered for and
kil'd 12 Wright Whales, sunk one unlifted one
and took two along side

Master Cruising for Whales

Friday Feb the 3^d
Commences fine weather from the Eastward
at 2 P.M. commenced cutting at and 7 P.M.
finish'd Land 30 miles distant, Middle and Latter
parts fine weather from S.E. to N.W. employed
hailing and staining down

Saturday Feb the 4th Lat 44 12 S
Commences fine weather from N.W. at 7 P.M.
finish'd staining down 141 lbs of Oil,
Middle part fine weather Latter calm, at 8
P.M. lowered for and got one Wright Whale
and at 3 P.M. took him along side
Lat 44 12 S

Sunday February the 5th
Commences light winds and calms employed
staining down, at dark finish'd staining
44 lbs and 12 gallons, Middle and Latter parts
light winds and calms from N.W. at 6 P.M.
commenced cutting, at 9 finish'd, and began
to stain down Oil, Lat 44 16 S

Monday Feb the 6th
Commences fine weather from N.W.
heading N.W. for the land, at 5 P.M.
finish'd staining down 83 lbs of Oil,
Middle and Latter parts fine weather at 6 P.M.
struck and kil'd 2 Wright Whales and at 11
P.M. took them along side, one Ship in
sight
