Thursday Feb. the 9th
Commences fresh gales from S.W. heading
S.E. under storm sails, at 7 P.M. more
to the Westward, spoke the Barque Mary
and Marther of Plymouth 2000 lbs
Middle and Latter parts more moderate at
6 P.M. commenc'd hailing and starting down
oil, at 11 P.M. finish'd starting down 65 bbls
Lat. by the 43.51 S

Friday Feb. the 10th
Commences light winds and a heavy
smell from S.W. heading West under easy
sail, employ'd hailing Middle and Latter
parts light winds and calms from S.W.
employ'd hailing, Lat. by the 43.34 S.

Saturday Feb. the 11th
Commences fine weather from N.W. heading
N.W. employ'd hailing Middle and Latter parts
fresh winds from N.W. employ'd hailing and
starting down oil, at 6 P.M. finish'd hailing.

Commences fresh winds and overcast weather from
N.W. to S.E. employ'd starting down at 7 P.M.
finish'd starting 81 bbls of oil, Middle part fine
weather Latter the same at 6 P.M. made all sail

Lat. by the 43.36 South

Monday Feb. the 13th
Commences fine weather from N.W. employ'd
setting up shacks and starting off between
decks Middle and Latter parts fine weather from
the Eastward working in shore, employ'd fitting
shacks and clearing up between decks set down
24 bbls of oil, Lat. by the 44.06 S

Tuesday Feb. the 14th
Commences fine breezes from the Eastward
steering N.W. under all sail, at sunset
took in sail, land bearing N.W. the East
part Middle and Latter parts light winds and
thick foggy weather from every point in the
Company employ'd whaling

Wednesday Feb. the 15th
Commences calm foggy weather at 4 P.M.
lained child a Right Whale at 5 took him
along side and at 7 finish'd cutting him in
fresh winds from South lying to under storm
sails Middle and Latter
parts fine weather
from Westward employ'd cutting
out our whale which was a dry skin
