Commences fresh winds from N.W. working to the windward to the windward Middle and Latten parts fine weather from N.W. to S.W.

Wednesday May the 3rd

Commences fine winds from the South, Steering N.W. by W. under all sail, at 1 P.M. the 2nd Officer went in shore with his Boat, at 4 returned double reefed the Tapsails, standing off shore Middle and Latten parts light winds from South at 10 P.M. Daysd Advanced in the Mouth of the River

Thursday May the 4th

Commences light winds from South at 5 P.M. cast Anchor in the harbor of Santacrus in 5 fathoms water Middle and Latten parts fine weather, at 8 AM the Capt. went to town to center the ship, at 9 P.M. return

Friday May the 5th

Commences light winds and rain from the North one watch on Liberty
