Commences fine weather from East
at 3 took them along side, at 4⁰⁰

finished cutting, and wind from West
N. West Cape bearing E. S. E.

Middle the same at daylight commenced
cutting the other at 9 A.M., finished and
cleared up the decks, Lat. by Obs. 22° 0' S
Long. by Obs. 110° 39' E.

Tuesday May the 15th
Commences fine weather from East
bearing S. E. employed sailing at 10
P.M. tack'd to South, wind from
E. S. E. Lat. by Obs. 21° 26' S
Long. by Obs. 113° 50' E.

Wednesday May the 16th
Commences fine weather from
E. S. E. heading South, employed sailing
Middle and Latter parts much the
same employed sailing Lat. 20° 06' S

Thursday May the 17th
Commences fine weather from East
heading N. W. E. at 4 P.M. finished
sailing, Middle and Latter parts fine
weather from E. S. E. heading N. E.
under all sail, Lat. Obs. 19° 36' S
Long. Obs. 114° 27' E.

Friday May the 18th
Commences fine weather from
E. S. E. heading South at daylight
commenced starting down sail
Lat. by Obs. 18° 44' S.

Saturday May the 19th
Commences fine weather from
East, at 5 P.M. finished starting
down, at 6 P.M. tack'd Ships
Ships in sight Middle and Latter
parts fine weather from E. S. E.
heading N. E. Lat. by Obs. 15° 25' S.

Sunday May the 20th
Commences fine weather from
E. S. E. at 4 P.M. spoke the Ships
Frances Henrietta of New Bedford
1350 of Whale, and 450 Sperm, and
Rodman of do, 900 of Whale, and 500
of Sperm, at sunset tack, in sail
heading South, at daylight made all
sail, steering N. E. Lat. by Obs. 18° 11' E.

Monday May the 21st
Commences fresh winds from East
at 4 P.M. Lay over for Whales but
could not strike at sunset have
too under short sail.

Having been sick for a number
of days I have not made up
my journal, as usual, but
there has nothing of importance
taken place will have been
between the Lat. of 19° 55' to
18° South and Long. of 115° to
116° 30' East, May the 21st
