Commences with moderate breezes from N<sup>o</sup> W<sup>o</sup> steering E S & with pleasant weather middle and latter part light winds from N<sup>o</sup> Lat by Obs 38:58 Long 61:35

Commences with strong gales from S W<sup>o</sup> with heavy squales of rain double reefed the topsails middle Part wind W<sup>o</sup> latter part pleasant made all sail Lat 38:40 Long 55:05

Remarks on board Wednesday September the 25

Begins with strong breezes from W<sup>o</sup> S W<sup>o</sup> steering E S & the watch employed fitting ship middle and latter part the same so ends this day Lat by Obs 38:16 N Long 48:41 W
