steering S E by E with pleasant weather at 11
P M saw a Ship steering N sent up the main
Royal and main topgallant studingsail
Middle and latter part light baffling winds
got a Suner Obs

Remarks on board Sunday September the 29

Commences with light baffling winds heading
from E S E to S E at 6 P M a steady breeze from
N E heading S E by E latter part heading E S E

Lat 36° 45' S Long 39° 30' W

Remarks on board Monday September the 30

Commences with fresh breezes from E heading
S S E with pleasant weather middle and latter
Part the same saw 3 Sail heading to the S E
At 9 P M got a Suner Obs

Lat 35° 00' Long by Obs 38° 33' by Suner 38° 12'

Remarks on board Tuesday October the 1st

Commences with fresh breezes from E to E N E
Heading from S S E to S E middle part squally took
In topgallantsails and single reefed the topsails
latter part strong winds from E heading S S E
Saw a Ship heading to the S so ends these 24 hours
