sea. Subject four steamers by the Cruik

Remarks on board Aug. 4 - 1840 -
these 24 hours Commences with pleasant weather
At 8 AM took our anchor and stood
out to sea. At 10 Discharged the Pilot
At noon sighted Venus Bear ESE Dist
15 Miles

Remarks on board Wednesday August 5th 1840
first part Commences with pleasant weather
Wind from N.E. Steaming S.W. by S at 6 PM
Tahiti Dist 15 Miles Middle part evening
and variable winds Latter pleasant weather
Employed fitting the Boats we now mean the W
4th Boat Lat by Ob 18 37 - Long by Chro 150-50

Remarks on board Thu. August 6th 1840
these 24 hours Commences with pleasant
weather with the wind ESE Steaming S.W. by W
at 2 AM the wind hauled to N.E.
Latter part Steaming S.W. ends these 24 hours
Lat by Ob 19-01 S Long by Chro 152-15 W

Remarks on board Frid August 7th 1840
All these 24 hours pleasant weather wind from the E
Steaming S.W. at 10 AM the wind hauled N Steaming
S.W. so ends these 24 hours Lat by Ob 19-38 S
Long by Chro 154-00

Remarks on board Sat August 8th 1840
these 24 hours Commences with pleasant weather
the wind N.E. Steaming S.W. by W at 9 AM had a
squall toward topgallant sails wind hauled N by E
steaming S by W at 10 AM set the top gallant
sails the latter part pleasant so ends Lat 20-25
Long by Chro 154-54-30

to Perotongo Newland Tarratt Master
Remarks on board Sun August 9th 1840
these 24 hours Commences with cloudy weather
with some rain wind from W Steaming
S.W. middle pleasant at 6 AM pleasant
S.W. Steaming S.W. Latter part pleasant
weather with gentle breezes from the W
ends these 24 hours Lat by Ob 20-12 W
Long by Chro 155-32

Remarks on board Monday August 10th 1840
these 24 hours Commences with a brisk breeze
from W at 12 CC back. d Ship Steamed to
the Southward latter part wind from S.W. Steaming
N.W. by W so ends Lat by Ob 20-20 S
Long by Chro 155-50 W

Remarks on board Tues August 11th 1840
these 24 hours Commences with pleasant
weather gentle breezes from W Steaming S by E
at 4 AM hauled Ship Steaming N.W. by W
at 6 AM saw a ship Steaming N.W. by W
the latter part of these 24 hours pleasant also
so ends Lat by Ob 19-43 S Long by Chro 156-40 W

Remarks on board Wed August 12th 1840
these 24 hours Commences with a light breeze
from W Steaming S by E middle part calm
Latter part light breeze from N.E. Steaming
S.W. all hands employed repairing the
main top sail so ends Lat by Ob 19-06 S
Long by Chro 157-17-15 W

Remarks on board Thu August 13th 1840
these 24 hours Commences with light variable
winds Steaming from S.W. by S by E at
12 past 10 saw the land bearing off from
us all hands employed repairing the main top sail so
ends these 24 hours Lat by Ob 19-41 S
Long by Chro 158-06 W

Remarks on board Frid August 14th 1840
these 24 hours Commences light variable winds
steaming from S.W. by S.E. hauled S.W. by CC
AM steamed toward Paganina N.W. by E Dist 7
miles Steaming S.W. by W West wind from N.W. by N
all hands employed mending sails so ends these
24 hours Lat by Ob 20-05 S Long by Chro 158-43-45 W
