Pleasant weather all these twenty four hours wind from the Westward steering East under all sail. So Ends.

Remarks on board Thursday 17th 1830

first and middle part pleasant breezes and clear weather latter part strong breezes from the SW and heavy steering E & S. Under all sail. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 39-16 N. Long by Cr 63-31 West

Remarks on board Friday 18th 1830

first part strong gales and clear weather middle and latter part rainy wind from the southward and Eastward steering to the North East. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 40-30 N. Long by Cr 60-39 West

Remarks on board Saturday 19th 1830

light air all these twenty four hours wind from the Eastward the ship heading to the southward and Eastward. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 40-13, Long by Cr 60-00 West

Remarks on board Sunday 20th 1830

light winds from the westward these twenty four hours and pleasant weather. So Ends, steering East.
Lat by Cr 40-19. Long by Cr 54-00, West

Remarks on board Monday 21st 1830

first part light winds and variable latter part pleasant breezes from the southward steering East Under all sail. Saw a plenty of Grampassers and pinbacks. So Ends.

Remarks on board Tuesday 22nd 1830

first part pleasant breezes from the westward steering East under all sail latter part calm and foggy wind variable from North to East. So Ends.

Remarks on board Wednesday 23rd 1830

light air and calm all these twenty four hours with thick foggy weather. steering to the South and Eastward.
Lat by Cr 40-39 Long by Cr 52-27 West

Remarks on board Thursday 24th 1830

first and middle part foggy with light variable winds at 2 P.M. saw some blackfish. Lowered the boats and caught one. latter part pleasant breezes from the westward and clear weather. So Ends, steering East.
Lat by Cr 41-00 N. Long by Cr 51-27 West

Remarks on board Friday 25th 1830

strong gales all these twenty four hours wind from the Westward steering East. Under all sail. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 41-30 Long by Cr 47-19 West

Remarks on board Saturday 26th 1830

strong breezes and clear weather all these twenty four hours wind from the westward steering S & E under all sail, so Ends. two sail in sight.
Lat by Cr 41-11 Long by Cr 43-00 West

Remarks on board Sunday 27th 1830

strong breezes and cloudy all these twenty four hours wind from the Westward steering S & E. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 40-39 N. Long by Cr 38-12
