first part Pleasant breezes and clear weather wind from the Westward. Latter part squally and rainy steering S.B. Employed in ship's duty. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 39-16 - Long by A. 33-43 West.

Remarks on board Wednesday 30th 1830

first and Middle part strong breezes and foggy wind from the Westward at 10 P.M. hove too at daylight saw the Island of Flores bearing E.S.E. Dist 30 miles at 10 A.M. lowered the boats and went on shore. So Ends.

Remarks on board Thursday July 1st 1830

fine weather all these twenty four hours. Employed in boating of Potatoes and Onions. So Ends.

Remarks on board Friday 2nd 1830

Light Air and calm all these twenty four hours wind variable at 6 P.M. came off from the shore and kept off S.B. for Fayal broke two ships and at 10 P.M. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 38-50 - Long by A. 31-07 West.

Remarks on board Saturday 3rd 1830

first part light winds and calm latter part pleasant breezes from the Southward at 10 A.M. spoke the Arm of Santia Capt. Bragton came on board at Meridian saw Fayal bearing East, Dist. thirty miles. So Ends.

Remarks on board Sunday 4th 1830

strong breezes and clear weather wind from the Southward all these twenty four hours at Meridian Fayal bore by compass S.E. Dist fifteen miles. So Ends.

Remarks on board Monday 5th 1830

light winds and pleasant weather these twenty four hours wind from the Southward at Meridian Fayal bore by compass East Dist 12 miles. So Ends.

Remarks on board Tuesday 6th 1830

Light Air from the Southward these twenty four hours with clear weather saw some porpoises and cow fish at Meridian Fayal bore by compass East Dist twenty miles.

Remarks on board Wednesday 7th 1830

Light Air and calm the first and middle part, latter part pleasant breezes from the Westward steering South under all sail. Several ships in sight. So Ends.
Fayal bearing by compass E by N. Dist 18 miles.

Remarks on board Thursday 8th 1830

Light winds and pleasant weather all these twenty four hours wind from the South and Westward, steering S.B. Lat by Cr 37-17 - Long by A. 22-20 West.

Remarks on board Friday 9th 1830

Pleasant breezes and clear weather all these twenty four hours wind from the Westward steering S.B. under all sail. Lat by Cr 36-06 - Long by A. 27-23 West.

Remarks on board Saturday 10th 1830

fine weather these twenty four hours wind from the Westward steering S.B. under all sail. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 34-28 - Long by A. 26-15 West.

Remarks on board Sunday 11th 1830

Pleasant breezes from the North and clear weather these twenty four hours, steering S.B. under all sail. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 32-23 - Long by A. 24-45 West.

Remarks on board Monday 12th 1830

strong trades and clear weather wind from N.E. steering South under all sail. Employed in ship's duty. So Ends.
Lat by Cr 29-53 N, Long by A. 23-51, 2.
