Strong trades and clear weather all these twenty four hours wind from the Eastward, steering SSW Under all sail. Employed in ship's duty. So Ends.

Remarks on board Wednesday 14th 1830

first part strong trades and cloudy latter part more moderate. steering SSW Under all sail. So Ends.

Lat by Obs 24-21. Long by Acc 21-22 West

Remarks on board Thursday 15th 1830

pleasant breezes and clear weather all these twenty four hours. one sail in sight. So Ends.

Lat by Obs 21-52 Long by Acc 21-38 West

Remarks on board Friday 16th 1830

first part strong trades from the North and Eastward latter part light airs from the North steering SSW

Lat by Obs 19-36 - Long by Acc 21-52 West

Remarks on board Saturday 17th 1830

Light airs and variable from S to SSW and thick weather. Employed in ship's duty. So Ends.

Lat by Obs 17-38 - Long by Acc 22-05 West

Remarks on board Sunday 18th 1830

Strong breezes from the Westward with thick weather these twenty four hours, at 4 PM saw the Isle of Sal, bearing S, dist 20 miles took in sail and hove to at daylight made sail and steered for Bonavista at Meridian saw the land bearing SSW dist 12 miles. So Ends.

Remarks on board Monday 19th 1830

Light airs and calms all these twenty four hours, wind variable, at 4 PM lowered the boats and caught two turtles at 10 AM caught ten others. So Ends.

Remarks on board Tuesday 20th 1830

Light airs from the southward the first and middle part, latter part Pleasant breezes from the North and Eastward, steering SSW at 2 PM saw Blackfish, lowered the boats and caught one, at meridian Bonavista bore by Compa SSW dist 30 miles from which I take my departure. So Ends.

Remarks on board Wednesday 21th 1830

Pleasant breezes and fine weather these twenty four hours wind from the Northward, steering South. So Ends.

Lat by Obs 14-06. S. Long by Acc 22-11, West

Remarks on board Thursday 22nd 1830

first part light airs from the Northward latter part strong breezes from the Southward and Eastward with some rain, steering by the wind SSW and S. So Ends.

Lat by Obs 12-37 - Long by Acc 22-06 West

Remarks on board Friday 23rd 1830

first part strong breezes and clear weather, latter part more moderate, wind from the South & Westward, steering West

Lat by Obs 12-21 - Long by Acc 23-37, West

Remarks on board Saturday 24th 1830

first light airs and calms with clear weather latter part squally and rainy wind from the South & Westward, So Ends.

Lat by Obs 11-59, North, Long by Acc 23-47 West

Remarks on board Sunday 25th 1830

light breezes and clear weather these twenty four hours wind from the Northward, steering South under all sail. So Ends.

Pleasant breezes and clear weather these twenty four hours wind from the Westward, steering South So Ends.
