Strong trades and clear weather all these twenty  
four hours. steering S.W. Under all sail. Employed  
in making a Mizzen top mast. so Ends -  
Lat by Cr 12-26 - Long by St. 25-29 West

Remarks on board Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> 1830

all these twenty four hours strong gales from the  
Eastward. steering S.W. under all sail. so Ends -  
Lat by Cr 14-58 - Long by Lunar 25-00

Remarks on board Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> 1830.

Commences with light winds from the Eastward  
Middle and Latter part strong breezes and clear weather  
steering S.W. Under all sail, set to the best Advantage  
Lat by Cr 16-54.1, Long by St. 25-23, West

winds from the Eastward. steering S.W. so Ends  
Lat by Cr 18-06 Long by St. 25-51, West

Squally and rainy all these twenty four hours  
wind variable from E. to S.E. steering S.W. -  
Employed in setting up rigging. so Ends  
Lat by Cr 20-26.1, Long by St. 26-11. West

Remarks on board Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> 1830

first and middle part strong breezes and squally  
Latter part fine weather wind from the North  
steering. S.W. under all sail. so Ends -  
Lat by Cr 22-21 - Long by St. 26-33 West

Remarks on board Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> 1830,

Squally and rainy these twenty four hours. wind from  
the Northward. steering South. Under all sail -  
Employed in sending down top Gallant mast and  
sending up others. and setting up the rigging  
Lat by Cr 24-11.1, Long by St. 26-33 West

Remarks on board Friday 20<sup>th</sup> 1830

Strong Gales from the Southward these twenty four  
hours, steering to the Eastward. Employed in unbenching  
and bending sails. so Ends  
Lat by Cr 24-44.1, Long by St. 24-36. West

Remarks on board Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> 1830

strong gales and clear weather the first and middle  
part Latter part light wind from the Southward  
Saw some birds and pinbacks. so Ends -  
Lat by Cr 25-35 Long by St. 23-16, West

Remarks on board Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> 1830

first and middle part strong breezes from the South  
and Westward Latter part light winds and clear weather  
Saw a plenty of birds and pinbacks, Employed  
in ships Duty. so Ends -  
Lat by Cr 26-22 - Long by St. 21-42, West
