Strong gales and squally weather. wind from the Westward
at 8 P. M. bore too with the ship's head to the Westward
at 4 A. M. made sail and kept of for Fayal. S. E. & S. E.

hours, wind from the North at Meridian the Island
of Fayal bore by Compass. S. E. Dist 10 miles.
