fine weather there twenty four hours wind from the
westward, at 2 PM the boat came off with some potatoes
discharged and went on shore again at 4 PM finish
getting of our supplies, and kept on our course. So End

Remarks on board Saturday 28th 1832
fine pleasant weather all these twenty four hours wind
from the Westward at 4 AM saw the Island of St. Michael
bearing by Compass S.W. Dist twenty miles. So End

Remarks on board Sunday 29th 1832
first part light wind and calms latter part pleasant
breezes and clear weather wind from the Southward
at Meridian the Michael bore by Compass S.W. Dist 24
Miles from which I take my departure. —

Remarks on board Monday 30th 1832
fine weather all these twenty four hours wind from
the Southward until 11 AM it then shifted to the
South & Eastward. So End, steering South under all sail.

Remarks on board Tuesday 31st 1832
Pleasant breezes and clear weather wind from the
Southward, all these twenty four hours. So End
steering S by E under all sail.
Lat by Cr 36-30 — Long by Cr 23-40

Remarks on board Wednesday August 1st 1832
Pleasant breezes and fine weather there twenty
four hours, wind from the North. So End
Lat by Cr 35-03 — Long by Chron 22-36.

Remarks on board Thursday August 2nd 1832
fine weather all these twenty four hours.
steering S by E under all sail. So End —
Lat by Cr 33-14 Long by Chron 22-24 West.

Remarks on board Friday 3rd 1832
these twenty four hours. the wind variable from North
to East. and fine weather. steering S by E under all sail.
Lat by Cr 31-10 West Long by Chron 22-00-30 West

Remarks on board Saturday 4th 1832
Strong trades and clear weather there twenty four
hours. wind from the Eastward. So End —
Lat by Cr 28-40 — Long by Chron 21-43-30 West

Remarks on board Sunday 5th 1832
Strong trades and cloudy there twenty four hours —
steering S.W. under all sail.
Lat by Cr 25-29 N Long by Chron 21-47-00

Remarks on board Monday 6th 1832
fine weather and moderate breezes all these twenty
four hours. steering S.W. under all sail —
Lat by Cr 22-51 — Long by Chron 21-00

Remarks on board Tuesday 7th 1832
Strong trades and clear weather there twenty four
hours wind from the North. So End, steering S.W.
Lat by Cr 20-32 — Long by Chron 23-02-15 West

Remarks on board Wednesday 8th 1832
moderate winds and thick hazy weather all these twenty
four hours wind from the North. steering S.W. So End
Lat by Chron 18-20 — Long by Chron 23-19 West.

Remarks on board Thursday 9th 1832
moderate all these twenty four hours at 5 AM saw
the Isle of Salt bearing by Compass S.W. at Meridian
the South part of the Island bore S.E. So End.
steering S.W. under all sail.
