four hours at Meridian saw St. Jago bearing East
Dist 30 miles; and Jago bearing S. E. to E. D.
Steering S. E. by E. Under all sail.

Remarks on board Saturday 11th 1832
fine weather all these twenty four hours wind varied
from E. S. E. to S. E. at 3 P. M. lowered the boats and
went on shore. So E. D. Lying off and on with the shore.

Remarks on board Sunday 12th 1832
moderate all these twenty four hours at 4 P. M.
came on board with the boat. So E. D.

Remarks on board Monday 13th 1832
Begins with moderate weather at 5 P. M. lowered
the boats and went on shore. So E. D.

Remarks on board Tuesday 14th 1832
fine weather all these twenty four hours wind from
the North at 3 P. M. the boats came off and brought on
board four Portuguese took them up and kept on
our Coors. So E. D.

Remarks on board Wednesday 15th 1832
fine weather all these twenty four hours wind
from the Northward Steering South Under all
sail. So E. D. Employed in ships Duty.

light air and calms all these twenty four hours
at 10 A. M. saw blackfish. Lowered the boats
and cast them. So E. D.
Lat by H. 12-29 Long by H. 24-30 West.

Remarks on board Friday 17th 1832
first and middle part calms and light air. Latter part
Pleasant breezes and clear weather. Steering South. So E. D.
Lat by Ls 11-27 Long by H. 24-20 West.

Remarks on board Saturday 18th 1832
Light Airs and calms all these twenty four hours
Employed in ships Duty. So E. D.
Lat by Ls 11-20 Long by H. 23-56-45

Remarks on board Sunday 19th 1832
calms all these twenty four hours. So E. D.
Lat by Ls 10-45 Long by H. 23-40 West.

Remarks on board Monday 20th 1832
first part calms middle and latter part equally
wind from the South and westward Steering S. E. to E. D.
Lat by H. 10-30 Long by H. 23-29 West. So E. D.

Remarks on board Tuesday 21th 1832
Strong breezes all these twenty four hours wind from
the South and Westward. Steering S. E. Under all sail
Lat by Ls 9-20 Long by H. 22-29 West.

Remarks on board Wednesday 22th 1832
Strong winds from the South and westward and clear
weather all these twenty four hours. Steering S. E.
Lat by Ls 7-27 Long by H. 19-40 West.

Remarks on board Thursday 23th 1832
Strong breezes and squally all these twenty four hours
wind S. E. Steering S. E. Under all sail. So E. D.
Lat by H. 6-31 Long by H. 17-55 West.

Remarks on board Friday 24th 1832
Strong breezes and fine weather. Steering S. E. by E.
at 8 A. M. took to the Westward. So E. D.
Lat by Ls 6-00 Long by H. 15-53 West.
