East to N.E., steering S by E. Under all sail -

wind from N.E. steering S.E. Under all sail.

weather latter part rainy wind from N.E. steering

first part squally and rainy middle and latter
part pleasant weather wind from the Southward
steering S.E. Under all sail, one sail in night
Lat by Obs 23-21 Long by Chron 20-44 West.

Remarks on board Friday 14th 1832
Strong breezes from the Southward these twenty
four hours steering to the Eastward at 6 P.M.
tacked ship to the South & Westward. so End -
Lat by Obs 24-3 - Long by Acc 20-40

Remarks on board Saturday 15th 1832
Pleasant weather these twenty four hours wind from
the Eastward steering S.E. Under all sail -
Lat by Obs 25-54 Long by Acc 20-28 West.

Remarks on board Sunday 16th 1832
Strong Gales from the North & Eastward all these twenty
four hours steering S.E. Under all sail. so End -
Lat by Obs 28-00 S, Long by Chron 18-34-30

Remarks on board Monday 17th 1832
Pleasant breezes all these twenty four hours
wind from the Northward steering S.E. Under all sail
at Meridian spoke ship Chili of New Bedford.
Lat by Obs 29-53 - Long by Acc 17-20 West.

Remarks on board Tuesday 18th 1832
Strong breezes and squally these twenty four hours
wind from the Northward at Meridian the wind
shifted to the South & Westward. so End. - - -
Lat by Obs 31-01 S Long by Acc 16-40 West.

Remarks on board Wednesday 19th 1832
Moderate winds and cloudy weather these twenty four
hours the wind from the Westward steering S by E.
Lat by Acc 32-45 S, Long by Chron 13-02-30 West.

the North and Westward steering S by E. Under all sail
Lat by Obs 34-50 N Long by Chron 13-02-30 West.

De Achuna bearing by Compass South West 35 miles

the Island bore by Compass S by E Dist 25 miles
