Monday Aug 29th
This day moderate and pleasant from various points ship with all prudent sail set heading to the eastward (course S by E) sails this day several sails in sight the hands employed at various jobs about the ship

Tuesday Aug 30th
First part light breeze from the south with pleasant weather ship with all prudent sail set heading to the eastward middle part moderate last part fresh breeze from S by E ship with all sail set one ship in company the hands employed at different jobs about the ship

Wednesday Aug 31st
First part moderate breeze from the S by E with squally weather ship steering S by E with all prudent sail set one ship in company the hands employed at various jobs about the ship
Lat obs 38.42. N
Long by act 62.00. W

Thursday Sept 1st
This day squally weather from various points with plenty of thunder & lightning ship head from S by E with all prudent sail set saw nothing the hands employed at various jobs about the ship
Lat by act 39.30. N
Long by do 63.20. W

Friday Sept 2nd
This day I fresh breeze from the south with squally weather ship head to S by E with all prudent sail set saw one sail in company the hands employed about ship
Lat obs 39.26. N

Saturday Sept 3rd
This day I sail from S by E with passing squally ship steering by compass S by E with all prudent sail set one sail in sight saw one ship this day all the hands employed at various jobs
