This day commenced with a fresh gail from W. Steering S at 120 P.M. close reefed the top sails by the wind. At 1 P.M. last part moderate from N.E. with pleasant weather all day light. Set all sail steered for Zanzibar at 5 P.M. the boat went on shore ship off & on under short sail so ends this day the boat on shore.

Saturday Sept 17th

Through this day a moderate breeze from W. with pleasant weather ship off & on at Zanzibar for recruits so ends this day all well. Pumps Cared for

Sunday Sept 18th

Commenced with a moderate breeze from various points with pleasant weather ship off and on at Zanzibar the boat on shore. Steered out just past 1 P.M. at 5 P.M. the boat went on shore at Pica ship off and on so ends this day all well the boat on shore for recruits. Pumps Cared for
