1844

Wednesday Sept 23rd 64

Through this day a fresh breeze from N.E. to N.W. with pleasant weather ship steering by Compass S.S.W. with all sail set saw nothing. Hands employed at various jobs about ship so ends this day Pumps Cared for

Thursday Sept 24th

Commenced with a brisk breeze from E.N.E. ship steering by Compass S.W. by S. with all sail set middle & last part moderate in the fore sight. Hands employed at various jobs about the ship so ends this day all well

Friday Sept 30th

Through this day a light air from N. to N.E. with pleasant weather ship steering S.W. by S. with all drawing sail set last part saw Black fish land got nothing. So ends this day Hands employed about ship

Saturday Oct 1st

Through this day light airs from N. with pleasant weather ship steering by Compass S.W. by S. with all sail set nothing in sight. Hands employed at various jobs about the ship so ends this day all well

Sunday Oct 2nd

This day light airs from various points with Calms ship steering by Compass S.S.W. with all sail set said a Bark steering W saw nothing more so ends this day

Through this day light airs from various points with Calms ship steering S.S.W. last part employed hooking out Bread & Belan to Cooper saw Black fish land got nothing so ends this day very moderate
