1864

Tuesday Oct 4th

Through this day a light air from S.E. with pleasant weather ship steering by Compass S.S.W. with all sail set saw nothing Hands employed making out & Coopering the Provisions & Stowing back again so ends this day

Lat obs 23° 55' N

Long by Chron 25° 04' W

Wednesday Oct 5th

Commenced with a moderate breeze from S.E. with pleasant weather ship by the wind S.S.W. Last part backing with rain ship with all sail set saw nothing Hands employed

Lat obs 24° 52' N

Long by Act 25° 25' W

Thursday Oct 6th

Through this day moderate breeze from S.E. with clearest weather ship by the wind S.S.W. with all sail set saw nothing Hands employed making out & Coopering Provisions & Stowing back so ends this day all well

Lat obs 24° 03' N

Long by Chron 26° 23' W

Friday Oct 7th

Commenced with a light breeze from S. & pleasant at 4 P.M. wind from S.E. & light exchanged Ensign with a Hamburg Bark steering N.N.E. Middle & Last part Light with Calms ship head different ways Hands employed Coopering & Stowing Provisions saw a Brig steering N.N.E.

Long by Chron 27° 07' W

Saturday Oct 8th

This day Light airs from various points with Calms ship head different ways with all sail set saw several sails steering to S.W. saw nothing more Hands employed making Coopering & Stowing away Provisions so ends this day the pumps cared for

Lat obs 23° 05' N

Long by Chron 26° 45' W

Sunday Oct 9th

First part Light airs from various points ship head to Southward with all sail set several sails in sight steering to S.W. first part finished Coopering the Provisions Last part squally from the west ship head S.W. nothing in sight so ends this day all well
