Monday Oct 10<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a moderate breeze from WSW  
Ship by the wind S. middle part wind W. Star  
S by W. Last part the same ship with all sail  
set nothing in sight. Hands employed at  
various jobs about the ship one man sic

Tuesday Oct 11<sup>th</sup>

Through this day moderate breeze from  
various points with pleasant weather  
Ship head from S by W to SE with all  
sail set nothing in sight. Hands employed  
at various jobs about the ship all well

Wednesday Oct 12<sup>th</sup>

Through this day light airs from various  
points with calms ship head from SSW  
to SE all sail set nothing in sight. Hands  
employed at various jobs about the ship

Thursday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>

This day very light airs with calms ship  
head SSW by S all sail set trying hard to  
get along but slow progress nothing in  
sight. Hands employed at various jobs

Friday Oct 14<sup>th</sup>

Through this day very light airs from  
different points with calms & pleasant  
weather ship steering SSW by S with  
all sail set at 4 P.M. saw St. Antonio bearing  
by compass S by E dist 45 miles last part  
day a whale steaming W by S saw black  
fish to ends this day hands employed  
at various jobs about the ship

Saturday Oct 15<sup>th</sup>

This day very light air from different  
points attended with calms ship steering  
SSW by compass St. Antonio bearing  
E dist 20 miles saw a ship steering SSW  
In company saw a brig to the west  
to ends this day hands employed
