1864

Sunday, Oct 16th

This day I light air from N. by E. with pleasant weather ship steering by compass S by W at 4 P.M. saw Blackfish Island struck and lost him last part exchanged signal with the English ship City of Peckin steering In Company at N. saw Blackfish Island struck & got one so ends this day St. Antone in

Long by Chron 25-42 W

Monday, Oct 17th

Commenced with a light air from E with pleasant weather steering S by W with all sail middle part took the last part specially two saw In sight hands employed boiling out the Blackfish & other jibs saw the Isle of Long & Brava having E dist 60 miles so ends this

Long by Chron 25-40 W

Tuesday, Oct 18th

Sprought this day a fresh trade with ship steering by compass S by W with pleasant sail set at 4 P.M. had a Boat to overboard board a Boat & caught him last part carried away the fore top mast studding sail boom so ends this day all several sails in sight steering to the N.

Sprought this day a brisk breeze from N. with pleasant weather ship by the wind S by W with all sail set saw several sails steering In Company saw nothing more hands employed at different jobs about the ship

Wednesday Oct 26th

This day a brisk breeze from N by E with pleasant weather ship by the wind S by W with all sail set several sails In Company one whaler saw two steering to N by E nothing more In sight hands employed

Thursday Oct 27th

Sprought this day a brisk breeze from S by E with pleasant weather ship by the wind S by W with all sail set several sails In Company saw nothing more

Lat obs 1-35 N
