Thursday Nov 3th

Commences with a fresh trade from S.E. by S. Ship by the wind S.E. by W with all sail set nothing in light Hands employed setting up rigging & other jobs about the ship.

Lat obs 12-50 S

Long by chr 30-58 W

Friday Nov 4th

Commences with a moderate trade wind & pleasant ship by the wind S.E. by W middle part the large last part passing square from E by S Steer S by W nothing in light Hands employed at different jobs about the ship.

Lat obs 14-28 S

Long by chr 30-59 W

Saturday Nov 5th

Through this day moderate breezes from E by S Ship steering S by E with all sail set one ship in company saw nothing more Hands employed at different jobs

Lat obs 16-41 S

Long by chr 30-09 W

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Sunday Nov 6th

Through this day a moderate breeze from E with pleasant weather ship steering by compass S by E with all sail set the sails in company saw nothing more.

Lat obs 18-34 S

Long by chr 29-20 W

Monday Nov 7th

Through this day moderate breeze from E with pleasant weather ship steering by compass S by E with all sail set one ship in company to the N.E. at 10 A.M. saw the Island of Grenada having S.W. by S dist fifty miles so ends this day all well Hands employed at various jobs about ship

Lat obs 19-50 S

Long by chr 29-59 W

Tuesday Nov 8th

Through this day light airs from E by N with pleasant weather ship steering by compass S.E. with all sail set last part employed repairing the fore top sail saw one morpeltite knigh by the wind E.N.E. Martin vast Rocks in sight to the S.W. dist 8 miles

Lat obs 20-42 S
