Through this day light air from different
ways with Calms ship steering S by E with
all sail set and a heavy swell from South
three sails in light steering to the N
nothing more in sight hands employed
at different jobs about the ship all well

Long by alt 27-53 W

Thursday Nov 10th
Through this day light air with Calms
ship with all sail set steering S by E by
Compass nothing in sight hands employed
at various jobs about the ship

Lat obs 21-14 S
Long by alt 27-42 W

Friday Nov 11th
Commenced with a calm ship steering S by E
middle part moderate breeze from different
ways last part a quick breeze from N by E
with pleasant weather saw Linbacks
so ends this day hands employed

Lat obs 22-31 S
Long by alt 26-58 W

Bark Java of New Bedford In The South Atlantic Ocean
1864

Saturday Nov 12th
Commenced with a moderate breeze from
N by W ship steering S by E with all sail set
last part wind from W by S with passing
squalls of rain ship with all prudent sail set
so ends this day nothing in sight

Lat obs 24-21 S
Long by alt 25-35 W

Sunday Nov 13th
Commenced with a fresh breeze from S by W
ship head S by E at 4 P.M. the wind S by W
with squally weather ship by the wind
S by E took in top Gallant sails S by E
and gave top sail middle part Strepers
wind last part more moderate from
S by E ship head S by E set all sail one
ship in company so ends this day

Lat obs 24-46 S
Long by alt 23-22 W

Monday Nov 14th
Commenced with a fresh breeze from S by E
ship by the wind S by E with all sail set
at 5 P.M. lashed to S by W two sails in
company middle part Calm last part
light air from the westward steering
S by E hands employed at different jobs

Lat obs 24-59 S
Long by alt 23-25 W
