1864

Tuesday Nov 15th
Through this day light breeze from different points with calm ship head to the South with all sail set two sails in company. Saw nothing more the hands employed at various jobs about the ship.

Long by Chron 23° 18' W

Wednesday Nov 16th
Through this day light breezes from S by E to S by W with pleasant weather ship by the wind to the S by W & S W one ship in company. Saw nothing more hands employed.

Lat obs 26° 28' S
Long by Chron 23° 40' W

Thursday Nov 17th
Begins with a moderate breeze from S by E with pleasant weather ship head S W with all sail set one ship in company. Last part moderate breeze from N by E stand S by E eight sails in company so ends this day.

Lat obs 27° 58' S
Long by Chron 23° 25' W

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Friday Nov 18th
Begins with a moderate breeze from N by E middle part wind from S by W fresh and squally took in the light sails took two Reefs in the fore top sail last part more moderate but misty set all sail again three sails in company.

Lat obs 27° 56' S
Long by Chron 21° 43' W

Saturday Nov 19th
First part a strong breeze from S with thick weather ship by the wind S by E with all sail set at S by E took in the light sails middle part took in the fore top sail took two Reefs in the fore top sail last part more pleasant set prudent sail. Two ships in company so ends this day.

Long by Chron 19° 28' W

Sunday Nov 20th
Begins with a fresh breeze from S ship head S by E with prudent sail last part wind bend to S W ship head S by E with strong wind with squalls took in the light sails took two Reefs in the fore top sail two sails in company.
