Monday, Nov 21th

Through this day a strong wind from SW with squalls ship steering by compass SSE with double reefed top sails courses & jibs one bark in company nothing more in sight so ends this day all well

Lat obs 31-57 S

Long by chr 15-27 W

Tuesday, Nov 22th

This day begins with a fresh breeze from SW by NW with quite pleasant weather ship with all prudent sail set steering S by E last part stand SSE nothing in sight

Lat obs 33-57 S

Long by chr 13-19 W

Wednesday, Nov 23th

Begins with a strong wind from SW by W with rugged weather ship with prudent sail set steering SSE by compass last part breeze moderate stand S saw finbacks saw a sail to the south

Thursday, Nov 24th

Through this day a fresh gale from NW with rugged weather ship steering SSE with prudent sail set middle part stand SE last part SSE with thick weather saw finbacks so ends this day all well

Lat by set 36-47 S

Long do 18-57 W

Friday, Nov 25th

This day moderate breeze from NW with heavy swell from W with smoky weather ship steering from SSE to ESE with all wearing sail set saw finbacks so ends this day all well

Lat obs 36-29 S

Long by chr 5-29 W

Saturday, Nov 26th

Through this day a fresh breeze from NW with rugged weather ship with prudent sail set steering SSE last part stand different ways crossing the ground saw plenty of finbacks

Lat obs 36-41 S

Long by chr 2-27 W
