

Lying at Anchor in Rumburg.

Tuesday Feb 7th

This day moderate from the South with pleasant weather ship at anchor one watch on shore the rest employed on board at different jobs. Mikel still of duty with his dogs.

Wednesday Feb 8th

This day pleasant from the SE one watch on shore the rest employed taking afternoon and other jobs on board the Sabine. Day went on shore and went through an operation. Mikel still off duty.

Thursday Jan 9th

This day various weather from various points with heavy rain thunder and lightning. Ship at anchor hands employed at various jobs about ship. Mikel still of duty and Abner George of duty do ends this day with Steamer master.

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Friday Feb 10th

This day thick overcast weather with thunder and lightning and plenty of rain from various points. Ship at anchor hands employed at various jobs. Mikel and Abner George still of duty.

Saturday Feb 11th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from the W with heavy thunder and lightning. The wind shifting away after 4:30 PM the lightning struck the main Royal Mast splitting it in pieces taking the head of the main top mast block and passing down opening the main mast for six feet ripping up the mast coat and following the chain and runboard damaging the fore Royal Mast and doing considerable other damage. Last part employed sending down the spars and fitting others the same men of duty.

Sunday Feb 12th

This day very pleasant weather from various points. Ship at anchor hands employed about ship at various jobs. The same men of duty do ends this day.
