

Lying at Ancho in Bumbury

1865

Sunday Feb 19<sup>th</sup>

Fine pleasant weather from W  
Ship at anchor all hands on board  
Ship near ready for sea middle and last  
part the same all hands on board

Monday Feb 20<sup>th</sup>

Begins with clear weather middle part  
much the same last part a fresh breeze  
from eastward with thick smoke  
gather ship hope short waiting for  
the smoke to lift and a breeze

Tuesday Feb 21<sup>st</sup>

Begins with a moderate wind from  
SW and clear the upper part of  
even anchor and stand out by the  
W & W middle and last parts  
and rigged ship with prudent  
sail set nothing in sight

Bound to the Southward

Wednesday Feb 22<sup>nd</sup>

Begins with a squall from WSW and  
Ship heading to south the land in sight  
middle and latter parts rugged weather  
with a good breeze SW to S the mate  
off duty sick suffering with pain

Lat. by obs. 34.24 S.

Long. Chron. 113.31 E.

Thursday Feb 23<sup>rd</sup>

Begins fine weather and a moderate breeze  
from the S ship heading W. S. W. middle  
part fresh breeze last part moderate  
from S. by W. ship heading S. by E.  
hands employed setting up rigging  
and other jobs about ship

Lat. by obs. 35.00 S.

Long. Chron. 113.42 E.

Friday Feb 24<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fine pleasant weather  
from the southward employed making  
the ship to the windward middle part  
the same more moderate from SW  
heading S. the mate better this morning  
the mate on duty again

Lat. by obs. 36.06 S.

Long. Chron. 111.49 E.
