1865

Saturday Feb 25th

Begins with pleasant weather from Southward heading S.W. by W. Middle part the same ship looking to the wind. Latter part very light airs from S.W. Ship heading S.E. hands employed

Lat. by obs. 36.40 N

Long = Chron. 112.13 E

Sunday Feb 26th

Begins with light airs from S.W. by S. Ship heading S.E. by S. at 2 P.M. the wind W. by N. Steered S.E. by E. with all sail set Middle part brisk with light squalls of rain. At 10 A.M. the wind from S.W. with heavy squalls took in all sail to double reef. And fore sail steering S.E. by S. at night more moderate but squally weather. So ends this day all well

Monday Feb 27th

Begins with a fresh wind from S.W. with overcast cast weather S.E. by E. with all prudent sail set Middle part wind W. by N. last part wind W. by N. Steered S.E. with sail set Hands employed at various jobs about ship saw nothing

Long = Chron. 117.48 E

Bound Southward

Tuesday Feb 28th

Begins with a fresh breeze from N.W. with cloudy weather ship steering S.E. with all drawing sail set Middle part the same last part brisk from W. by N. with pleasant weather Steered S.E. by E. with a heavy swell from N.W. nothing in sight Hands employed as usual

Long = Chron. 121.29 E

Wednesday March 1st

Begins with a moderate breeze from W. with pleasant weather and a heavy swell from S.W. ship with all sail set steering S.E. by E. Middle part light air from N.W. last part air very light from N. with smoky weather nothing in sight Hands employed at various jobs about ship

Lat. by obs. 41.42 N

Long = Chron. 123.12 E

Thursday March 2nd

Begins with a moderate breeze from S. with hazy weather and a heavy swell from S.W. steering S.E. by E. at 4 P.M. fresh breeze from N.W. Middle part rainy. Last part strong wind from W. by N. with a heavy swell from S.W. and pleasant weather. Ship with all drawing sail set saw nothing

Long = Chron. 124.02 E
