Begins with a calm at 4 P.M. a quick breeze from S by E steered at 5 P.M. wind N by W and light ship head W middle part and last parts light breeze from E to ESE with pleasant weather ship steering N by E hands employed fitting rigging saw nothing

Begins with a light breeze from SE with pleasant weather ship steering N by W middle and last parts light from various points and pleasant ship head various ways hands employed at various jobs about the ship saw nothing

Lat by obs 6:24 S

Long = Chron 173-42 E

Tuesday April 12th

Begins with a light air from SE and pleasant middle and last parts light from various points ship steering N by W with passing squalls of rain ship with all sail set employed at various jobs Richard of duty with the venerable

Lat, by obs 6:05 S

Long = Chron 173-45 E

Thursday April 13th

Begins with a light breeze from W steering N by W all sail set middle part wind light from various points and pleasant last part wind N by E all sail set hands employed cleaning the iron work nothing in sight
