

Bound to the Bechth Sea

1865

Wednesday April 26th

Begins with a strong trade wind from N.E. Ship steering N.W. by N with all sail set at 4 P.M. Steered N.W. Middle part the same last part steered N.W. by W with all sail set saw nothing Richard Bainbridge still of duty

Lat by Obs. 14-17

Long = Chron 162-03

Thursday April 27th

Begins with a fresh trade and pleasant Ship with all sail set steering N.W. by W Middle part strong breeze with squalls last part fresh and pleasant all sail set nothing in sight Bainbridge of duty

Lat by Obs. 17-20

Long = Chron 161-35

Friday April 28th

Begins with a brisk breeze from N.E. and pleasant Ship with all sail set steering N.W. by W Middle part squally last part fresh and pleasant nothing in sight Hands employed at various jobs Bainbridge still of duty

Lat by Obs. 19-55

Long = Chron 160-20

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Saturday April 29th

Begins with a fresh breeze from N.E. with pleasant weather Ship with all sail set steering N.W. by W Middle part the same last part more moderate and pleasant employed at various jobs saw nothing Bainbridge still of duty

Lat by Obs. 22-25

Long = Chron 159-15 E

Sunday April 30th

Begins with a moderate breeze from N.E. with pleasant weather Ship with all sail set steering N.W. by W at 4 P.M. Steered N.W. by W Middle part much the same last part very fine weather from East steering the same nothing in sight Richard Bainbridge still of duty

Lat by Obs. 25-00

Long = Chron 158-51 E

Monday May 1st

Begins with a fine breeze from East with pleasant weather all sail set steering N.W. by W at 4 P.M. Steered N.W. by W Middle part moderate from S last part much the same employed repairing the main sail and fore top sail saw nothing so ends this day Bainbridge of duty

Lat by Obs. 26-45

Long = Chron 158-53 E
