Begins with a fresh wind from the  
wind veered steering NW with all  
prudent sail set Middle part the same  
last part fresh from SW with heavy fog  
all sail set saw pinbacks so ends this day  
Richard Bainbridge still of duty

Tuesday, May 9<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a fresh wind from SW  
with heavy weather ship with all sail set  
steering NW with all sail set Middle part squally  
with lightning took in light sails doubled  
reefed the top sails last part more made  
set all sail steering NW by N at 10 A.M. wind  
veered to NW with all sail set so ends this day  
Bainbridge of duty

Wednesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a fresh breeze from N  
steering NW by N all sail set at 2 P.M.  
the wind very light Middle part calm  
last part fresh breeze from N with  
thick rainy weather took in light  
sails saw plenty of pinbacks so ends  
this day Richard Bainbridge of duty

# Bound to the Behatka Sea

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Thursday, May 11<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a strong breeze from NNE with  
rainy weather ship head NW at 5.30 P.M.  
doubled reefed the fore top sail close reefed  
the main took in jib and spanker a thick  
snow storm Middle part wind NW took in  
the fore top sail at 3 A.M. wore ship to NE  
set fore top sail again at 10 A.M. let the  
reefs out of the main top sail set jib and  
spanker two sails in sight spoke ship  
George Howland Jones from Hayadada  
Bound to the Arctic Ocean so ends this  
day Richard Bainbridge still of duty

Begins with a strong wind from NW  
with squalls of snow ship head NE  
with prudent sail set Middle part made  
set all sail last part the same with pleasant  
weather from NW by W Bainbridge of duty

Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a moderate breeze from  
WNW with pleasant weather ship  
with all sail set by the wind N  
Middle part much the same last part wind  
WNW ship by the wind NE with thick  
fog saw nothing at 11 A.M. tacked to  
NW so ends this day Bainbridge of duty
