Tuesday June 13th

Begins with fine clear weather and light air. The boats off in chase of whales at 2 P.M. the boats returned having seen plenty of whales they fastened to one foggy set in lost the whale and the line. Middle part calm with thick fog, lost part the lifted up sent the boats off again saw nothing. Employed at various jobs about ship the two boats not yet returned so ends this day.

Wednesday June 14th

Begins with fine weather from SW the boats off looking for whales the ship came to the two boats came on board had seen three could not strike them middle part calm foggy part much the same the two off looking for whales hands on board at 10 A.M. the two boats from up the bay reported heavy ice could not get to the head of the bay so ends this day all well.

Thursday June 15th

Begins with fine pleasant weather and light air from various quarters at 1 P.M. the boats returned not seen any thing at 3 P.M. sent off all the boats shortly the foggy shut at night the boats returned got nothing middle part foggy lost part light and pleasant the boats off looking for whales saw nothing but plenty of ice so ends this day.

Laying at Anchor in North East Harbour

Friday June 16th

Begins with light winds from various quarters and pleasant weather all the boats off at midnight three boats returned the other boat by the whale they tykened at 3 P.M. all the boats went back the whale in tow at 8 A.M. had him along side employed cutting at the finished and started the boats away again saw nothing at 8 P.M. returned

Saturday June 17th

Begins with fine pleasant weather saw whales sent the boats off the boats got nothing at 4 P.M. the boats returned to the ship middle part much the same last part light foggy and light air from SW at 3 P.M. sent off the boats and started the workers boiling with the ship keepers so ends this day boats all off looking for whales.

Sunday June 18th

Begins with light showers of rain and a light breeze from SE ship boiling at 4 P.M. the boats all on board they had seen one seal middle part clear weather and a fresh breeze from W.E. employed boiling the boats out looking for fish but returned without seeing any thing two boats started again for 3 P.M. day so ends this day finished boiling out.
