

In Southwest Bay

1865

Saturday Aug 5th

Begins with a fresh breeze from S.W. with pleasant weather ship with all sail set working up the bay at 2.30 A.M. dropped anchor at 4 A.M. saw two whales aboard without success at 11 A.M. took anchor steered up the bay thick cloudy weather from N.E. so ends this day

Sunday Aug 6th

Begins with a fresh breeze from E.N.E. with rain at 4 P.M. anchored at Elbow Island in 8 fathoms of water middle and last parts a gale from N.E. with thick rainy weather so ends this day

Monday Aug 7th

Begins the same at 6 P.M. the wind from S.W. took anchor stood out N.W. the weather more pleasant middle and last parts brisk breeze and pleasant ship head down way with all sail set nothing in sight

Tuesday Aug 8th

Begins with a moderate breeze from E. with pleasant weather ship working toward Shant Bay last part pleasant entered Shant Bay dropped the anchor on account of head tide sent two boats off on the E. side of the bay saw nothing

Wednesday Aug 9th

Begins with very light weather and pleasant ship at anchor the two boats not yet returned last part foggy

Thursday Aug 10th

Begins with light pleasant weather middle part the same last part foggy ship still at anchor saw nothing the two boats not yet returned hands on board employed at various jobs

In Shant Bay

Friday Aug 11th

Begins with light breeze and calms with fog ship at anchor at 3.30 P.M. the boats returned reported seen nothing middle part calm last part pleasant with light fog at 6.30 A.M. took anchor wind from N.E. employed working to the N.W. the Bark Helene in company so ends this day

Saturday Aug 12th

Begins with a light breeze from the N.W. and foggy ship with all sail set working to the N.W. at 5 P.M. dropped anchor on account of tide at 7 P.M. took anchor heading different ways last part strong gale from N.E. with thick rainy weather ship with prudent sail set

Sunday Aug 13th

Begins with a gale from N.E. with thick rainy weather at 2 P.M. anchored in N.E. Harbour with the starboard anchor in 8 fathoms of water gave 30 fathoms of chain received Willis Adams on board Aug 11th when the Captain had shipped at Caroline Harbour middle part thick and rainy with rugged weather last part more moderate but rainy and thick ship at anchor

Monday Aug 14th

Begins with light breeze from various points and rainy at 1 P.M. took anchor worked out of the bay middle part thick and rainy last part the same saw nothing

Tuesday Aug 15th

Begins with light rainy weather one ship in sight ship with all sail set last part light but rainy at 5 A.M. dropped anchor on account of tide at 7 A.M. took anchor stood to E.N.E. wind N. spoke Bark Sun had one whale seen this in Loughs bay
