

After Leaving the Bays Bound South

1865

Sunday Oct 8th 65

Begins with a fresh breeze from S W with smoky weather ship with all sail set steering S by E, middle and last parts moderate from NW and pleasant all sail set nothing in sight so ends this day

Lat by obs 53-47
Long Chron 149-31

Monday Oct 9th

Begins with moderate weather from S W steering S E, middle part calm last part fresh breeze from S to S E ship on different tacks with prudent sail set thick weather no observations

Tuesday Oct 10th

Begins with a strong wind from S E by S with thick weather ship head E by N at 3 P.M. tacked to S W by S middle and last parts fresh breeze from S ship on different tacks working to S E with prudent sail

Wednesday Oct 11th

Begins with strong winds from S with thick weather ship on different tacks double reef jib and main sail in middle and last parts the same

Lat by obs 53-40
Long Chron 152-30

Thursday Oct 12th

Begins with more moderate weather from S S W ship head S E with a heavy head swell middle part wind S W ship head S E, last part wind W by S with squalls took in light sails jib spanker took 2 reefs in the top sails steering S by W nothing in sight

Bound to the Eastward

Friday Oct 13th

Begins with a fresh breeze from W with passing squalls ship with all prudent sail set steering S E, middle part more moderate last part the same wind S S W at 5 A.M. saw Eds Island bearing E dist 40 miles at 6 A.M. tacked to W with all sail set lay a bark to the W at 10 A.M. spoke Bark Menecoff from Jan bound to Cithay took from her two passengers Mr Randall and Mr Fisher so ends this day working to the south saw pinbacks

Long 154-30 E

Saturday Oct 14th

Begins with a fresh breeze from S W with thick weather ship with all sail set on different tacks middle part the same last part wind N W with pleasant weather at 9 A.M. passed out of the sea thro' the fifty passage steering S E with all sail set saw pin backs, hands employed repairing the ply jib and other jibs

Lat by obs 49-36 N

Long Chron 156-00 E

Sunday Oct 15th

Begins with a fresh breeze from N with pleasant weather steering E S E with all sail set middle part a strong gale from E by S with thick weather ship by the wind S E under short sail a heavy swell from S E last part the same

Lat by obs 48-30 N

Long obs 157-40 E
