1865

Monday Oct 16th

Begins with a fresh gale from E. P. E. with cloudy weather ship by the wind. S. E. with double reef in the top sails. Last part the same but blowing heavy heavy took in fore top sail close reefed the main thick rainey weather and a heavy swell from S. E. so ends this day

Long, do, 157.30 E.

Tuesday Oct 17th

Begins with the same weather from E. N. E. at 4 P. M. the wind S. E. and moderate more ship to E. let the fore top sail middle part moderate from S. E. let all sail heaving E. S. E. last part fresh breeze took in light sails

Wednesday Oct 18th

Begins with a fresh wind from S. steering E. S. E. middle part wind S. W. steered E. by S. last part fresh from S. W. all prudent sail set

Thursday Oct 19th

Begins with a fresh breeze from S. W. with passing squalls steering E. by S. all prudent sail set middle part the same last part more moderate from W. by N. with squalls all drawing sail set hauled off duty with a soar finger

Friday Oct 20th

Fresh breeze from N. W. to N. E. with pleasant weather steering E. by S. all sail set

Saturday Oct 21st

Begins with a fresh breeze from N. W. with cloudy weather steering E. by S. E. with all sail set middle and last parts moderate from N. E. to E. with cloudy weather sent up main Spencer kept nothing in light

Sunday Oct 22nd

Begins with very light weather from N. E. with cloudy weather ship by the wind E. S. E. middle and last part the same Lat by obs 42.35 N
Long Chron 174.05 E.

Monday Oct 23rd

Begins with very light wind from N. W. with cloudy weather ship by the wind E. with all sail set middle part the same last part fresh from N. W. with pleasant weather ship steering E. with all sail set

Lat by obs 42.07 N
Long Chron 176.30 E.

Tuesday Oct 24th

Begins the same and steering E. middle and last parts wind N. W. with squalls ship with all prudent sail set

Lat by obs 41.10 N
Long Chron 179.25 E.

Wednesday Oct 24th

Begins with a strong wind from N. W. and pleasant steering E. N. W. with all prudent sail set middle and last parts more moderate changed the day for west longitude saw plenty of fin backs

Lat by obs 40.40 N
Long Chron 176.05 E.

Thursday Oct 25th

Begins with a moderate breeze from S. steering E. N. W. middle and last part light and calm ship head different ways saw nothing
