

# Bound out from Honolulu

1865

Wednesday Dec 14

Beginning with good weather and moderate wind from N.E. after dinner the pilot came on board at 3 P.M. the ship was under way at 4 P.M. the Captain with our two second mates Mr. Williams came on board, kept the ship off S.W. middle part and latter part clear weather and moderate trade wind W.S.W. at breakfast time four strangers on board, the steward, one boatman Maryell Selvin and two prominent hands, all of the Mission.

Thursday Dec 15

Beginning with good weather and moderate wind from the E. steering W.S.W. with lower and first part of the day fairly set, middle and latter part fair weather and moderate trade from the E. steering W.S.W. the watch began in breaking out our beef and pork and preserving it.

Friday Dec 16

Beginning with good weather and moderate wind from the E. steering W.S.W. the watch still busy at the beef and pork, middle part the wind hauls to the Southeast cause the same latter part squally with fresh breeze from S.E. cause the same, it being quite rugged the ship being light, but not over so, we were compelled to give up breaking out for the present.

# In the North Pacific Ocean.

Saturday Dec 16

Beginning with clear weather and fresh breeze from S.E. steering W. by S. middle part bad weather at 9 P.M. had a very heavy squall of wind and rain with thunder and lightning from the Southward, took in the cargo and double reefed the topsails the weather squally throughout the night, latter part occasional rain squally with light air from the Westward set cargo and were ship heading to the Southward, during the forenoon made all sail.

Sunday Dec 17

Beginning with cloudy weather and light air from W.N.W. heading S.W. middle part good weather and light wind from W.N.W. steering W.S.W. latter part clear and pleasant with light air from the same quarter cause the same.

Monday Dec 18

Beginning with clear pleasant weather and light wind from N.E. steering S.W. middle part good weather and moderate wind from N.E. steering S.W. latter part partially cloudy with light wind from the E. steering W.S.W. the watch employed in breaking out beef and pork and preserving it.
