1866

Sunday March 11th 1866

Begins with fine pleasant weather from ENE ship with all sail set steering NNE & so ends this day nothing in sight

Begins with a fine breeze from E by N with pleasant weather ship steering N with all sail middle part the same last part light from ESE and pleasant employed painting boats and other jobs about ship saw nothing

Begins with light airs from SSE with fine pleasant weather steering N middle and last part S to SSW and pleasant ship with all sail set hands employed at various jobs nothing in sight so ends this day

This day light and pleasant from S to W steering NPPW with all sail set saw nothing

Begins with light airs from WPPW with pleasant weather middle part calm rain last part light breeze from NNE with smoky weather ship with all sail set steering NPPW by N hands employed at various jobs about the ship so ends this day nothing in sight

Begins with light breezes from the NNE with pleasant weather steering NPPW by N with all sail set middle and last part much the same saw nothing hands employed

Begins with very light and pleasant weather from various ways ship on different ways with all sail set saw nothing hands employed

Begins with light pleasant weather from different ways middle part light breeze from NE steering NPPW by N at 5.30 A.M. saw St. Juan one of the Bonson Island having NW by N dist 25 miles hands employed saw nothing

Monday March 19th

Begins with light pleasant weather from SE at 3.30 P.M. sent a boat on shore at 5 P.M. returned middle part wind SPPW steered NPPW by N last part fresh breeze from WPPW ship head N with all prudent sail set saw pinbacks
