

At Anchor in Shantar Bay

1866

Monday July 23

Boeing with fog rain and light breeze from the Westward at 2 P.M. the fog lights up a little got under way at 4 came to anchor middle part clear with moderate wind from S.W. at 3 A.M. got under way at 7 a thick fog and rain came to anchor again

Tuesday July 24

Boeing with fog and rain and light wind from S.W. at 1 P.M. got under way at 2.30 came to anchor at 1 A.M. got under way at 5 A.M. sent off starboard and waigt boat, saw whale, bowd the other boat

Wednesday July 25

Boeing with a calm the boats chasing at 6 P.M. they returned middle and latter part moderate wind from S.W. came through the Gut at 3 A.M. sent off starboard and bow boat, hauled up the waigt boat also gammed with the Comet

Thursday July 26

Boeing with clear weather and moderate wind from W. N.W. at 1 P.M. the boat returned at 2 came to anchor at 6.30 got under way middle and latter part clear with moderate wind from the Westward, the starboard and bow boat went off, the Captain going

Friday July 27

Boeing with clear weather and light breeze from S.W. at 2 P.M. the two boats returned to the ship middle part clear with moderate wind from the same quarter latter part saw whale, bowd starboard and waigt boat in a short time the latter boat struck a large cow and the waigt boat the calf brought them along side and cut the in

Saturday July 28

Fine weather the 24 boy saw whale bowd for them and the waigt boat struck another large cow brought it alongside and cut it in

Sunday July 29

Boeing with fine weather and moderate wind from S.W. saw whale, bowd the boat but did not strike started the work gamming with the Comet middle part clear with fresh breeze from S.W. latter part wind and weather the same saw whale, bowd the three barboard boat but did not strike

Monday July 30

Boeing with hazy weather and light wind from S.W. saw plenty of whale, bowd but did not strike middle and latter part light wind from the Eastern lower harbor and waigt boat, they return unsuccessful

Tuesday July 31

Boeing with hazy weather and light wind from the Eastern middle part fine weather and wind moderate from the same quarter at 10 P.M. came to anchor latter part hazy with light variable air, boiling and strong down sent off two boat, but it freezing up fresh returned

Wednesday Aug 1

Boeing with hazy weather and light wind from N.W. got under way saw whale, bowd waigt and starboard boat at 5 P.M. came to anchor middle part cloudy with fresh breeze from N.E. latter part calm, still boiling and two boat

Thursday Aug 2

Boeing with good weather and light wind from the Northward stern down, stern at 2 P.M. got under way heading W. still boiling at 4 came to anchor at 9 got under way at 6 A.M. came to anchor again a thick fog cooled down the work

Friday Aug 3

Boeing with cloudy weather and light wind from the Westward at 1 got under way heading S.W. at 6 came to anchor middle part thick fog and calm plenty of whale, latter part the same plenty of whale, bowd starboard and waigt boat, strong down in the afternoon finished the stern down altogether 227 barrels having 20 on deck
