

At Anker in Shanker Light

1866

Wednesday Sept 19

Begins with cloudy weather and moderate wind from E. N. E. received in boat from boat load of wood and three spar middle part good weather and light Northwesterly air at 9 P.M. got under way latter part cloudy and light wind from the Westward beating to windward

Thursday Sept 20

Begins with good weather and light wind from the Northwester steering E. by N. 20 gullies with the Comet middle part good weather and moderate wind from N. W. latter part good weather and and fresh breeze from the same quarter saw two whales lower three boats but could not strike

Friday Sept 21

Begins with good weather and moderate wind from N. W. heading N. N. E. at 7 P.M. started sail middle part good weather and moderate wind from same quarter at daylight made sail latter part fine weather and moderate wind from N. W. E. steering S. W.

Saturday Sept 22

Begins with clear weather and light air from N. E. heading to the Southward middle part good weather and fresh breeze from E. N. E. beating to windward latter part clear with fresh breeze from the same quarter put the chum in the run and kept her off for Bell's staff

Sunday Sept 23

Begins with cloudy weather and calm at 1 P.M. came to anchor middle and latter part clear and fresh breeze from S. E. took out the pump to overhaul them and put them in good order

Monday Sept 24

Begins with a rain storm and fresh breeze from N. E. finished the pump and replaced them middle part a rain storm and strong breeze from the same quarter latter part the rain continuing and wind hauly to S. W. and breeze up very low lower meridian head to the Westward

At Anker in Helesloff Harbor

Tuesday Sept 25

Begins with good weather and moderate wind from the Westward in boat gunning on fishing and another cylinder after boat, misty at 4 P.M. set the signal for the boat and got under way middle and latter part light wind and clear weather beating to windward at 7 A.M. came to anchor at 8.30 got under way saw 5 or 6 whales lower between and wait for

Wednesday Sept 26

Begins with clear weather and light wind from N. W. saw more whales lower than the two boats at 6 P.M. came to anchor middle part good weather and strong wind from N. W. at 4 P.M. got under way latter part clear weather and strong breeze from same quarter saw a whale lower the three boats in harbor and side, wait boat struck and before noon had the whale alongside

Thursday Sept 27

Begins with fresh breeze from S. W. all hands busy cutting fish by supper time middle part clear and calm the watch employed in clearing away the deck, head of latter part weather the same started the work at 10 A.M. a light breeze from the Westward, Drunken off duty with pain in the breast, and Sylvia boat steered with a jamming finger

Friday Sept 28

Begins with cloudy weather and moderate wind from the Northward middle part clear weather and light wind from W. S. W. the ship by the wind under easy sail, employees boiling the old cork off duty with saddle, testicle the other two men still off duty

Saturday Sept 29

Begins with cloudy weather and moderate wind from the Westward still boiling, middle part cloudy with moderate wind from N. E. still boiling, latter part the same finished boiling the whale turning up over 100 barrels
