

Bound in Helixoff Harbor

Sunday Sept 30

Begin with cloudy weather and fresh breeze from N.E. at 6.30 P.M. came to anchor full sail and made every thing snug middle part rain with strong winds from N.E. latter part clear and wind more moderate from N.E. all hand, stowing down oil in main hatches

Monday Oct 1

Begin with clear weather and light wind from N.E. fresh stowing down the whole stowing down 113 barrels middle part cloudy with strong wind from N.E. latter part wind and location the same took off a raft of water

Tuesday Oct 2

Begin with cloudy rainy weather and moderate wind from N.E. rainy and squally from N.E. latter part the same all hands busy stowing away sprays clearing up deck &c

Wednesday Oct 3

Begin with showery weather and light wind from N.E. middle part good weather and moderate wind from N.E. at 3 A.M. got under way latter part moderate wind from the same quarter afterwards haul to S.E. then to N.W.

Thursday Oct 4

Begin with cloudy threatening weather and light air from S.E. steering N.E. middle part clear with strong wind from N.E. double reefed the top sail at 8 A.M. came to anchor in Helixoff harbor full sail and made every thing snug the oil heating broke out and from the east remainder of the day the weather the same

Friday Oct 5

Begin with rainy squally weather from N.E. & dark at anchor here middle part good weather and moderate wind from the Northwest latter part clear weather and light wind from same quarter employed in sending up foretopgallant and fore repairing sail &c

Saturday Oct 6

Begin with good weather and light North wind very still repairing sails middle part clear and calm at 4.30 A.M. got under way the wind light from the Northwest latter part wind and weather the same beating out between the islands

Sunday Oct 7

Begin with fine weather and moderate wind from N.N.E. still between the islands gamine with the Cicero middle part clear and calm latter part clear with a light breeze from the Westward the tops of the masts were covered with snow

Monday Oct 8

Begin with clear cool weather and fresh breeze from S.W. running along the land part down the cutting & see but steadily sail and set them middle and latter part fine weather and a good breeze steering E. and E by S. several sail in sight going the same way

Tuesday Oct 9

Begin with fresh wind from S.W. steering E by S and S by E all sail set last part light three sails in sight steering the same

Lat obs 54° 33' N
Long Chron 146° 00' E

Wednesday Oct 10

Begin with light pleasant weather from S.W. steering S by E all sail set middle and last part fresh from S.W. by S with thick rainey weather took in Starboard and Bow Boats took the waist boat on Starboard side

Long Chron 148° 34' E

Thursday Oct 11

Begin with fresh wind from S.W. more pleasant steering S by E middle part very light from S.W. last part moderate from S by W ship by the wind S by E
