

At Anchor in Honolulu

1866

Thursday Jan 15

The same hot weather prevails, the carpenters still at work at the bow

Friday Jan 16

The same as the preceding day. The weather the same and the carpenters still at work, the ship keeled over and nothing can be done until they right as far as ship's duty is concerned. At night this day, all well carpenters still at work

Saturday Nov 17

Begin with pleasant weather ship at anchor carpenters still at work on the ship last part passing showmen of rain so ends this day hands empty

Sunday Nov 18

Begin with warm weather all hands allowed to go ashore money being provided for that purpose, the flags at half mast there being several deaths among the shipping

Monday Jan 19

The same hot weather prevails, the carpenters still at work at the bow right ship

Tuesday Jan 20

Warm weather the order of the day, the boys firing the flags again at half mast commenced stowing off in the hold, a party still busy stowing our oil in the hold

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Wednesday Jan 21

Begin with the usual warm weather to day Joachim went ashore to see the doctor and was returned back again, nothing being the matter with him, the crew busy setting up shooks and stowing of the hold, the whole of our oil, not yet stowed

Thursday Jan 22

Warm weather as usual, the same duty still going on on board ship as the last two days, setting up casks and attending to the shipment of our oil

Friday Jan 23

Begin with the same hot weather still setting up shooks, middle part weather the same, latter part received on board a water boat load of water, about 55 barrels and stowed it in the lower hold

Saturday Jan 24

Begin with hot calm weather finished shipping our oil in the hold middle part calm and hot, latter part weather the same all hands busy setting up casks and stowing them down

Sunday Jan 25

Warm weather the order of the day the crew allowed to go ashore money having been given them for that purpose and all returned at night, latter part occupied in stowing off the lower hold

Monday Jan 26

The same duty going on as in the previous days fitting the ship for sea

Tuesday Jan 27

Still occupied in fitting the ship for sea to day dy changed Drank Silena Brown brought down 60 barrels of water from the outer boat
