Tuesday Dec 11

Begins with strong winds and squally weather from E. N. E. steering S. S. E. middle and latter part wind weather and course the same, four men off duty the old cook the new cook and two foremast hand

Wednesday Dec 12

Begins with clear weather and fresh breeze from E. N. E. course S. S. E. middle and latter part wind weather and course the same, the 4 men still off duty

Begins with strong winds and squally weather from E. N. E. ship with all prudent sail set steering S. S. E. middle and latter part the same weather at 8 A. M. steered S by W

Friday Dec 14

Begins with strong winds from E. N. E. with heavy squalls ship with prudent sail set steering S by E middle and latter part the same fair weather

Begins with strong wind from E. N. E. attended with squalls ship with prudent sail set steering S by E middle and latter part the same nothing in sight

Begins with strong winds and squalls from E. N. E. steering S by W with prudent sail set middle and latter part much the same

Begins with strong wind from E. N. E. and rugged ship with prudent sail set steering S middle and latter part the same employed at various jobs about the ship

Begins with more moderate weather and pleasant from S. steering by the wind middle and latter part wind S by S ship by the wind S by E saw Blackfish land got over

Begins with fresh winds from E by S ship by the wind S by E with prudent sail set middle part shortened sail for the night ship on different tacks at 6 A. M. made sail steered S W employed repairing the main sail and other jobs nothing in sight
