top Gallant sail middle and last part the
same employed repairing the sails three
sails in sight to the westward so ends this

Sunday Jan 13th

Begins with squally weather from NW ship
heavy rain middle and last part the same
split the main top sail bent weather on
ship head different way with prudent sail

Monday Jan 14th

Begins with squally weather from NW ship
Ship head N middle and last part light with
calms ship head different ways saw 3 tanks
and 2 open Isles having SW and SE

This day begins pleasant middle and
last part thick and squally steering N
wind from different ways saw 3 tanks
Salomon and Clarks Island no observat

Wednesday Jan 16th

Begins with squally weather from
the wind very changeable ship
steering NW middle part the same
last part pleasant saw Blackfish 4 or 5
two boats got nothing very light weather

Thursday Jan 17th

Begins with rainey weather from NW
middle and last part rainey from the E.
steering NW saw nothing no observat

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Friday Jan 18th

Begins with thick rainey weather from
the NW ship head SW at 6 PM wind
N by E ship head NW by S middle and last
part much the same ship head different way

Saturday Jan 19th

Begins with light wind from NW ship
steering NW all sail set Piece on ditto again
middle and last part wind from the westward
steering NW overcast weather saw nothing

Begins with light wind from NW steering NW
middle and last part pleasant steering the
same with all sail set saw a Bark to
the NW in company saw nothing more

Begins with light pleasant from the NW
steering NW middle and last part the same
at 10 PM saw Simpson Isle having SW dist
15 miles saw a Bark to the E in comp

Begins with brisk wind from NW ship head
NW NW spoke Bark William Ratch nothing
middle and last part squally all sail
set the Ratch in company saw nothing

This day fresh wind and squally from NW
ship head NW NW Curved away jib boom
employed making another in sight
