Begins with light wind from N with  
overcast weather ship by the wind NW  
middle and last part the same saw nothing  
Lat Obs 24 51 N  
Long Obs 168 15 E

Friday Jan 25<sup>th</sup>

Begins with a fresh wind from NW by E  
steering NW by W by W with all sail set  
sent out the jib boom middle and last  
part the same employed making fly jib  
boom and other jobs painting ship  
Lat Obs 3 45 N  
Long 167 02 E

Saturday Jan 26<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh wind from NW by steering  
NW by W with all sail sent out the fly jib  
boom middle and last part the same the  
Ratch in light steering the same way  
Lat Obs 5 01 N  
Long Obs 164 26 E

Sunday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh wind from NW by  
ship steering from NW by W to NW by W  
in company with the William  
Lat Obs 6 57 N  
Long Obs 162 26 E

Monday Jan 28<sup>th</sup>

Begins with moderate wind from NW  
steering NW by W all sail set middle and  
last part the same employed at var  
jobs about ship the Ratch in light  
Lat Obs 8 02 N  
Long Obs 160 52 E

Tuesday Jan 29<sup>th</sup>

This day fresh wind from NW by  
all sail set steering NW by W set  
top mast and lower shudding sail  
Lat Obs 9 10 N  
Long Obs 158 16 E

Wednesday Jan 30<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh wind from NW  
steering NW by W all sail set Linnick Boat  
steerer still off duty middle and last part  
the same steering NW by W saw nothing  
Lat Obs 10 35 N  
Long Obs 154 53 E

Thursday Jan 31<sup>st</sup>

Begins with fresh wind from NW with  
pleasant weather steering NW by W with  
all sail set middle and last part squally  
Lat Obs 11 32 N  
Long Obs 152 12 E

Friday Feb 1<sup>st</sup>

Begins with strong winds from NW and  
squally steering NW by W with all  
present sail middle and last part more  
moderate set all sail saw nothing Frank  
Boatsteerer still off duty sick  
Lat Obs 12 57 N  
Long Obs 149 20 E

Saturday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup>

This day fresh wind from NW and pleasant  
steering NW by W with all sail set  
Lat Obs 14 44 N  
Long Obs 147 27 E

Sunday Feb 3<sup>rd</sup>

Begins with fresh wind from NW and pleasant  
ship with all sail set steering NW by W at 2 30  
saw the Isle of Japan bearing NW dist 40 miles  
at 8 PM shortened sail by the wind NW by W  
at 4 AM heard 9 40 for the Island saw  
three whales off shore at 10 AM came  
to anchor in eleven fathoms of water  
gave the ship 35 fathoms of chain on  
the front anchor made all preparation  
for whaling if there is any chance  
to land this day Frank Boatsteerer off duty
