

At anchor at Lyppan

1867

Monday Feb 4th 1867

Begins with fresh wind from the N.W. and pleasant ship at anchor last part saw and struck and killed a whale lost him by one iron breaking and two lines got cut so ends this day boats run

Tuesday Feb 5th

Begins with fresh winds and pleasant at 3 P.M. the boats on board bridle part rainy last part pleasant saw whales off shore hands employed at various jobs about ship

Wednesday Feb 6th

This day fresh wind and pleasant ship at anchor saw whales off shore land got nothing very shy hands employed painting and calking ship out side and other jobs about ship so ends this day

Thursday Feb 7th

This day fresh winds and squalls from N.W. ship at anchor boats out saw two whales no chance the hands employed painting and other jobs about ship

Friday Feb 8th

This day begins with moderate wind from N.W. middle and last part fresh and squally saw whales got nothing hands employed painting and calking ship out side

Saturday Feb 9th

This day begins with strong winds from N.W. with heavy squalls ship at anchor middle and last part the same two whales on shore so ends this day

Sunday Feb 10th

Begins with rainy weather ship at anchor middle and last part the same two boats coes on shore

Ship Laying at Lyppan

Monday Feb 11th

This day begins with quite pleasant weather from N.W. middle and last part more pleasant saw two whales off shore no chance ship at anchor hands employed about ship

Tuesday Feb 12th

Begins with strong wind from N.W. with plenty of rain ship at anchor middle and last part the same saw whales land got nothing the Bark Messman and Bark Nauticus came in to anchor so ends this day

Wednesday Feb 13th

Begins with stormy weather from N.W. ship at anchor middle and last part the same saw a few whales land got nothing so ends this day

Thursday Feb 14th

Begins with pleasant weather from N.W. ship at anchor saw whales land no chance middle and last part strong wind and squalls of rain employed repairing a boat and other jobs about ship

Friday Feb 15th

This day strong wind from N.W. with squalls ship at anchor last part saw whales land struck one lost him by the lines getting cut so ends this day

Saturday Feb 16th

Begins with pleasant weather ship at anchor last part squally two boats out looking for whales saw nothing at 2 P.M. ship anchor land about to leave boats on ahead of the ship looking for whales saw none
