Ship at Tinian

Sunday Feb 17th 1867

Begins with pleasant weather at 3 P.M. struck and killed two Humpbacks on Sun at 4 P.M. anchored by the whail in 32 fathoms of water at Tinian took but saw a whale to the ship last part cut one the other sinking very heavy let him lay

Monday Feb 18th

Begins with squally weather ship at anchor last part cut the whail and commenced boiling the weather more pleasant two boats but after whails got nothing

Tuesday Feb 19th

Begins with light pleasant weather two boats out got nothing employed boiling at 4 P.M. took anchor went in to 19 fathoms of water dropped the Starboard and gave the ship 45 fathoms of chain

Wednesday Feb 20th

This day pleasant weather from N.E. ship at anchor employed boiling saw no whale got nothing the whales very shy no chance so ends this day

Thursday Feb 21st

Begins with pleasant weather from N.E. ship at anchor employed boiling two boats out after whales got nothing middle and last part the same weather

Friday Feb 22nd

Begins with pleasant weather from N.E. employed stowing the down two boats out looking for whales saw none middle and last part the same weather finished

Ship at Lypar

Saturday Feb 23rd

Begins with light wind from S with pleasant weather at 5 P.M. dropped anchor in 12 fathoms of water gave the ship 45 fathoms of chain on the Starboard anchor last part strong wind from N. and rigged employed setting up shacks

Sunday Feb 24th

Begins with strong winds from N. with quite a heavy sea ship at anchor saw nothing middle and last part the same so ends this day very rigged weather

Monday Feb 25th

Begins with strong wind from N. P. E. but quite pleasant middle and last part blowing strong with squalls ship at anchor saw whales no chance employed setting up shacks

Tuesday Feb 26th

Begins with very squally weather from N.E. ship at anchor last part the same saw whales heard struck and killed one had to anchor the whale on account of the weather so ends this day

Wednesday Feb 27th

Begins with fresh wind and rigged one boat by the whale middle part moderate kept all the boats toward the whale to the ship last part employed cutting the whale so ends this day

Thursday Feb 28th

Begins with fresh wind at 2 P.M. finished cutting commenced boiling middle and last part pleasant saw whales heard got nothing employed boiling
